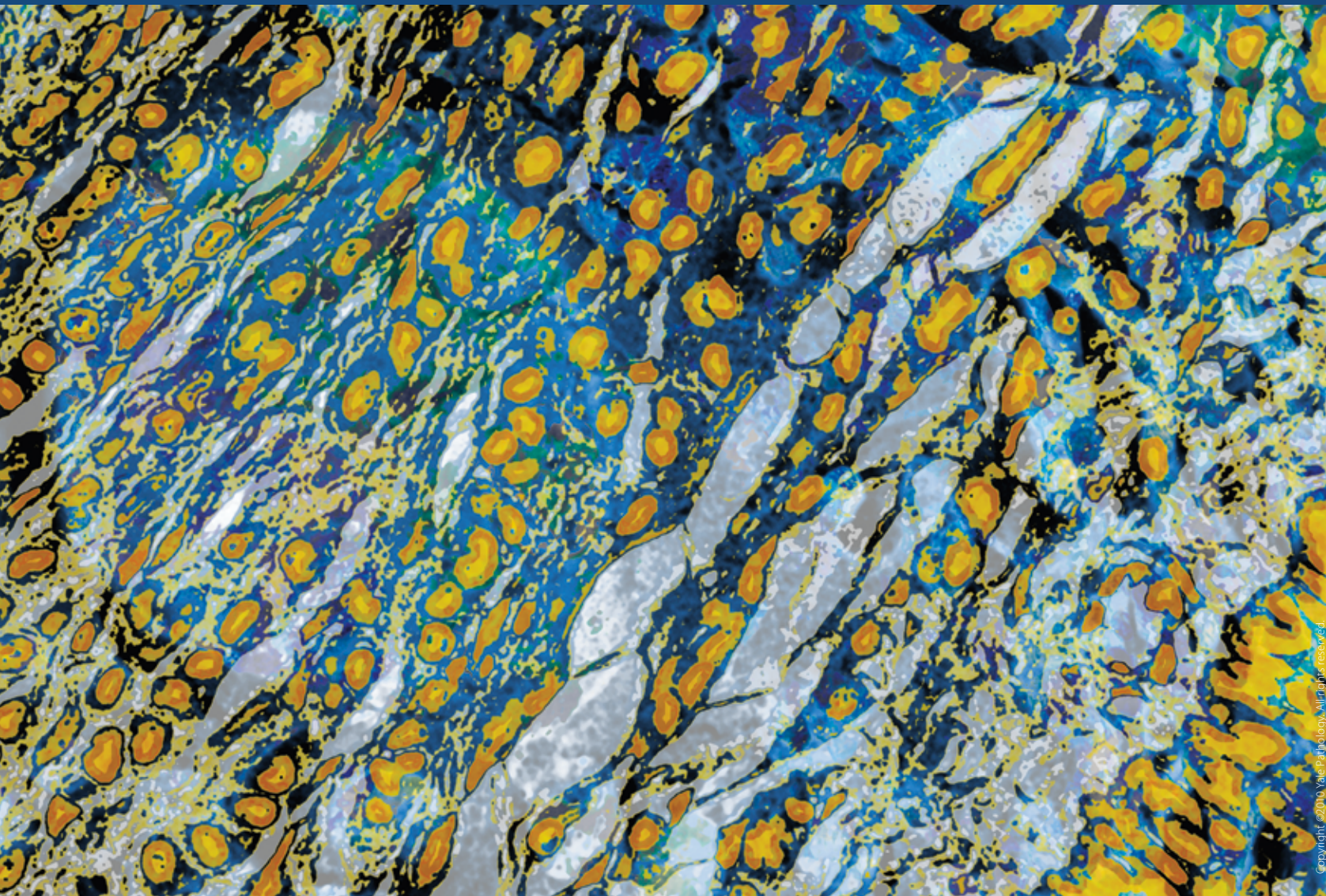
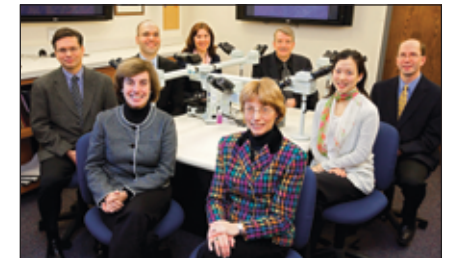


Dermatopathology
