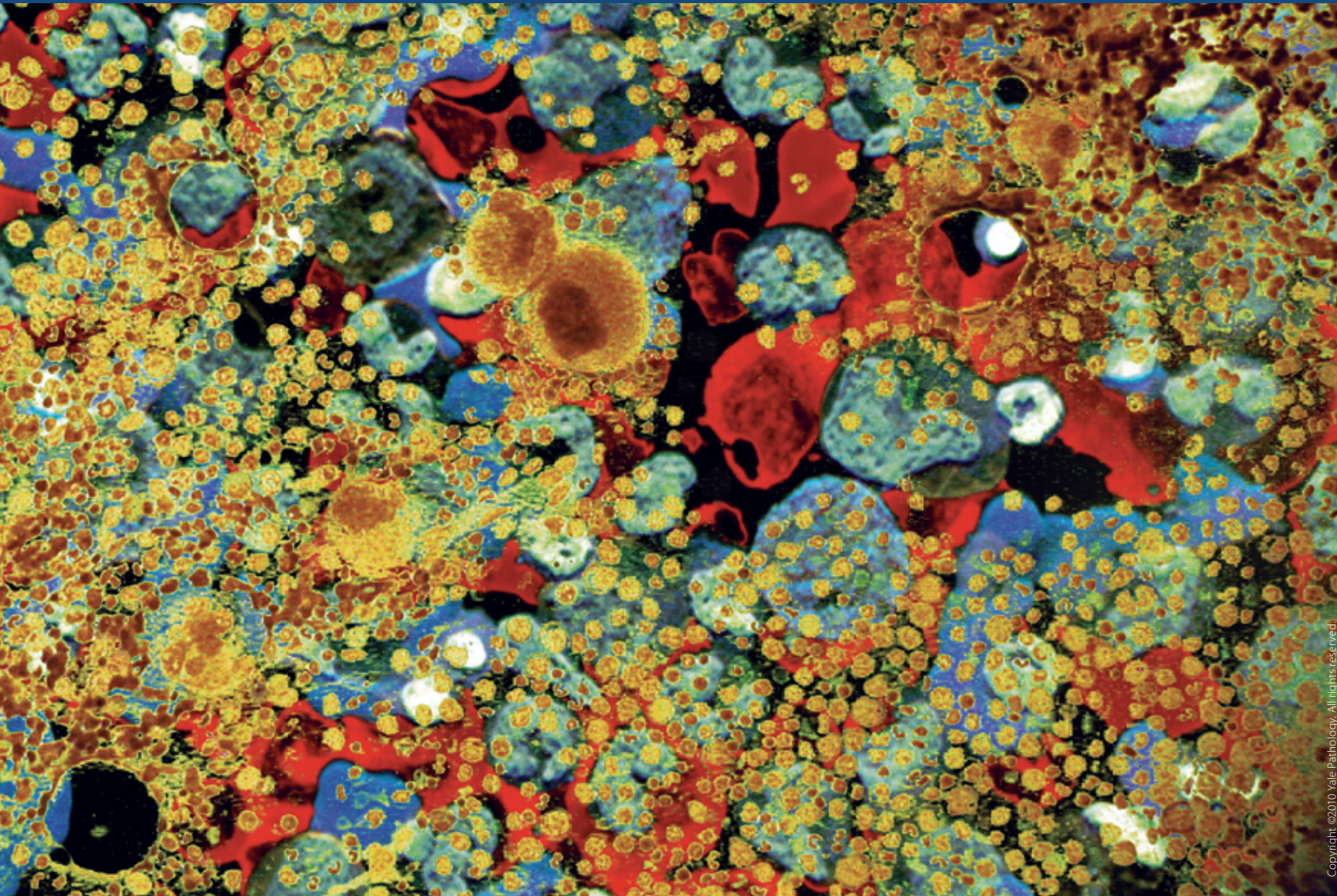


Hematopathology
