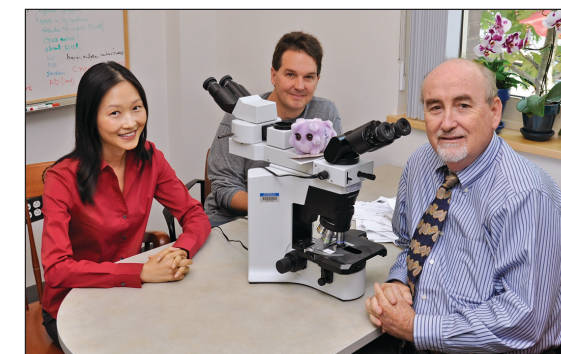


## Hematopathology
